Recipe of the Month

Bacon Wrapped Duck Breasts

Ingredients

6-8 Cleaned Duck Breasts
6-8 Pieces of Bacon
Sliced fresh or pickled jalapenos
1/2 a cup cubed cream cheese or
your favorite cheese
Balsamic vinegar or Italian dressing
Salt and pepper
Any other favorite spice

Directions

Marinate each duck breast in
balsamic vinegar or Italian dressing
along with salt and pepper and
favorite spice for at least 4 hours.
Open each breast and place a cube
of cheese and slice of jalapenos.
Fold over breast to cover it. Take
slice of bacon and wrap duck breast
all the way around the breast and
use a toothpick to keep it together.
You can bake, broil, or grill. Grilling
is preferred method. Place on hot
grill and rotate every few minutes.
When cheese starts coming out it's
ready.
